
ST. JOSEPH CEMETERY

In 1826 Franz Adam Knapp donated land from his farm for a cemetery at St. Joseph. This cemetery is located on Waterloo Road adjacent to St. Joseph Church and St. Joseph School.

We had difficulty reading many of the stones in the original section due to the age and deterioration of the stones, and because many of these stones are in German. People who read German were contacted and a German dictionary and alphabet were used, but we were still unable to transcribe some of the stones. Early records were destroyed by fire.

Our Lady of Lourdes Grotto was built about 1926. It was dedicated on Aug 14, 1927, and resembles the original shrine in Massabielle, France.
